Washtenaw Intermediate School District (WISD), a countywide regional educational service agency, has an ongoing need for Substitute Teachers and Teacher Assistants.

Minimum qualifications:

- Teachers must possess a valid Michigan teaching certificate **OR** have 90 hours of credit from a four-year college or university

More about the opportunity:

WISD's Special Education classrooms are comprised of students from the nine local school districts in Washtenaw County. Students exhibit a range of special needs including cognitive impairments, physical impairments, and emotional impairments. Some students require assistance with self-care and other daily activities.

Each WISD classroom is staffed by a teacher and one or more teaching assistants.
