

# Video Recording



Video can be a useful tool for you and your child's early intervention team. It allows you and other team members to see your child "in real time" to collect information, plan intervention strategies, solve problems, and monitor progress together.

Families have reported watching recordings of their child (and themselves) with their early intervention team helps them feel like an equal member of the team. Families have also shared they appreciate having the video documentation of their child's progress.

Before recording, your prior written consent will be obtained for the specific purposes outlined in a consent form (e.g. at home visits, team meetings, to be shared with other assessment and/or intervention partners, or for supervision).
